

Cotton Slippers, Made with Love

Materials

- Crochet hook, size F
- Yarns:

For the Slipper

Cotton yarn, in main colour (*I used Bernat Handicrafter*)

1-3/4 ounces (50 grams) 80 yards

For the Trim + Heart

Acrylic yarn, baby sport weight in two contrasting colours

- Yarn needle



Abbreviations used

Chain	ch
Slip stitch	sst
Single crochet	sc
Half double crochet	hdc
Double crochet	dc
Treble crochet	trc

Instructions :

Slipper:

R1 Into a magic ring, chain 2 (does not count as a hdc) make 12 hdc. Join with a sst into the top of the ch 2. 12 hdc made.

R2 Ch 2. Make 2 hdc into each space. Join with a sst into the top of the ch 2. 24 hdc made.

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R3- R8: Ch 2. Make 1 hdc into each space. Join with a sst into the top of the ch 2. 24 hdc made.

You can modify the length of the slipper in the following steps. For a longer slipper, go beyond R20, for a shorter one, do fewer.

R9-R20: Ch 2. Make 1 hdc into the next 18 spaces. Ch 2, turn. 18 hdc made.

Last row of slipper:

1 hdc in each of the first 6 spaces, 1 sc in each of the next spaces, 1 hdc in the last 6 spaces. Fasten off. Leave a long enough tail (5 inches) with which you will bind the back of the slipper. Weave in ends.



Trim:

With a contrasting colour:

1. Starting in the back of the slipper, join contrasting acrylic yarn and sc evenly all around the slipper. Join with a slip stitch to the joining chain.
2. Ch 1, sc until you get to about 1.5 inches from the slipper toe cap, chain 10, sst at an even distance across the slipper, about 1.5 inches from the toe cap. Continue to sc to the back of the slipper. Join with a sst. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Heart:

With a contrasting colour:

Into a magic ring, chain 4, 3 trc, 3dc, ch-1, 1 trc, ch-1, 3 dc, 3 trc, ch3, sst into ring. Pull on tail to tighten up magic ring. Fasten off, leave a long enough tail (about 5 inches) with which you will attach heart to the slipper.
